Notice is hereby given that on June 13, 2008, the following described applications for a Permit to Transfer the Location of Use and Type of Use of Surface Water Appropriation have been filed by Jessie & Danette Buker Family Trust, Opal Crow, and Carol Wright under the provisions of Nebr. Rev. Stat §46-290 to 46-294.05, for the surface water appropriations described below:

These applications were filed as a requirement for participation in the Nebraska Platte-Republican Resources Area Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). The proposed location of use is downstream of the current points of diversion to the point where the Republican River crosses the Nebraska/Kansas state line. The proposed change is to be temporary for the term of the CREP contract, which will be 14 years.

Under the provisions of Nebr. Rev. Stat § 46-291(1)(e) the quantity of water that is transferred to the new use may not exceed the historic consumptive use under the appropriation or portion thereof being transferred. The "Grant in cfs" described above is the total appropriation that is attached to the acres described above.

Any interested person wanting to object to and request a hearing on the above described applications shall file a formal objection/request with the Department of Natural Resources, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676 by July 25, 2008, in accordance with Department rules Title 454 N.A.C. 7.005. Each objection/request shall state the person's interest, the basis of the objection/request, and shall be accompanied by a \$10 filing fee.
